IQAC SUMMARY REPORT – 2016 -2017

Significant Activities and contributions made by IQAC

- IQAC suggested that while preparing the list of programmes to be organised by various departments for the academic year 2016 2017, the vision, the mission of the college, the industries expectation of the skills to be possessed by the students are to be kept in mind. Accordingly the departments have prepared the list of programmes in such a way that they would develop their soft skills, enhance their knowledge in the concerned area of study and develop positive attitude.
- IQAC, after consultation with the faculty members of various departments assessed the need for the Faculty Development Programme to be conducted and accordingly advised the heads of the departments to arrange for the same.
- IQAC also suggested the placement co-ordinators to find out the exact requirements and the nature of tests to be conducted by the companies visiting the college for recruiting students and accordingly training schedule should be prepared and training given rigorously.
- The members of each department are also encouraged to prepare as many monographs as possible in a year and circulate them among the members of the institution and other institutions for comments for improvement.

MoU's Signed

The college have signed MoU with the companies/Institutions like Star Associates for 3 years to get students trained for companies to use the expertise available in the institution.

Seminars and Conferences Organized

The departments of Computer Science, Commerce and Business Administration together organised 6 workshops, 14 guest lectures, 27 seminars, 4 Extension activities, and 2 FDPs. 8 members of the department of Computer Science and 1 member of the department of Business Administration, 3 members of Computer Science and 5 members of Mathematics department served as resource persons.

Research Details

On the Research side, 4 Faculty scholars are pursuing M.Phil programme and 13 Faculty scholars are pursuing Ph.D. programme. As like 45 Student scholars are pursuing M.Phil programme and 9 Student scholars are pursuing Ph.D. programme.

As the Management encourages research among faculty and the students by providing monetary assistance, the faculty members published 30 papers in various reputed national and international journals. In addition, by participating in number of seminars and conferences, the faculty members have presented 48 papers during this academic year.

Administrative Training Programme

Computer training is provided to all the support staff. They are encouraged to enhance their qualification joining distance education program. In case they become eligible for appointment to a higher cadre or to a teaching position they are either promoted or absorbed as a lecturer.

Bridge Course

Bridge course is conducted for newly admitted students by the department of English, mathematics, commerce, and computer science for 30 hours to bridge the gap between school and college education. It helps the students to have a smooth transition from school to college.

Placement and Training

Regarding placement of students in various companies, we are proud to declare 11 companies (such as ILM, TCS, IDBI, Alcance, Infosys etc.,) have visited the college so far and 161 offers were received by the students in the interviews conducted on and off campus.

Similarly the TCS one of the top IT Companies, as a part of their CSR choose our college every year invariably for giving training in the name of "Affirmative action Training program", totally free of cost for 100 hours to the economically backward and socially downtrodden students of our college. 90 students were benefited by the training. Similarly Infosys also conducts a free training program for 100 hours in the name of "Global Business Foundation Skills" to the students in which about 150 students benefited.

Co curricular Activity

Participation of the students in any one of the activities (Viz) Seminars, Conferences, Workshops and Symposia etc. conducted by other colleges during their courses of study is compulsory for the award of degree and it should be duly certified by the Head of the Department and submitted to the Controller of Examinations with a copy of the certificate of participation
