IQAC SUMMARY REPORT – 2019 -2020

Significant Activities and contributions made by IQAC

- IQAC suggested that while preparing the list of programmes to be organised by various departments for the academic year 2019 – 2020, the vision, the mission of the college, the industries expectation of the skills to be possessed by the students are to be kept in mind. Accordingly the departments have prepared the list of programmes in such a way that they would develop their soft skills, enhance their knowledge in the concerned area of study and develop positive attitude.
- The members of each department are also encouraged to prepare as many monographs as possible in a year and circulate them among the members of the institution and other institutions for comments for improvement.
- IQAC, after consultation with the faculty members of various departments assessed the need for the Faculty Development Programme to be conducted and accordingly advised the heads of the departments to arrange for the same.
- IQAC also suggested the placement co-ordinators to find out the exact requirements and the nature of tests to be conducted by the companies visiting the college for recruiting students and accordingly training schedule should be prepared and training given rigorously.

MoU's Signed:

The college have signed MoU with the companies/Institutions like ICT Academy for a year, Taking Yak for 3 years, Infosys BPM Limited for 2 years, Chrysalis EZ Vidhya Private Limited, and Tata Consultancy Services for a year to get students trained for companies to use the expertise available in the institution.

Seminar and Conference Organized

The departments of Computer Science, Commerce, and Business Administration together organised 17 workshops, 3 guest lectures, 50 seminars, 5 extension activities, and FDPs. 4 member of the department of Computer Application, 2 members of the department of English, 7 members of the department of Mathematics and 2 member of the department of Commerce PA served as resource persons.

Research Details

On the Research side, 11 scholars are pursuing M.Phil programme and 14 scholars are pursuing Ph.D. programme.

As the Management encourages research among faculty and the students by providing monetary assistance, the faculty members published 22 papers in various reputed national and international journals. In addition, by participating in number of seminars and conferences, the faculty members have presented 23 papers and students presented 57 papers during this academic year.

Administrative Training Programme

Computer training is provided to all the support staff. They are encouraged to enhance their qualification joining distance education program. In case they become eligible for appointment to a higher cadre or to a teaching position they are either promoted or absorbed as a lecturer.

Bridge Course

Bridge course is conducted for newly admitted students by the department of English, mathematics, commerce, and computer science for 30 hours to bridge the gap between school and college education. It helps the students to have a smooth transition from school to college.

Placement and Training

Regarding placement of students in various companies, we are proud to declare 24 companies (such as CTS, TCS, IDBI, KGISL, Infosys etc.,) have visited the college so far and 606

offers were received by the students in the interviews conducted on and off campus.

Similarly the TCS one of the top IT Companies, as a part of their CSR choose our college every year invariably for giving training in the name of “Affirmative action Training program”, totally free of cost for 100 hours to the economically backward and socially downtrodden students of our college. 90 students were benefited by the training. Similarly Infosys also conducts a free training program for 100 hours in the name of “Global Business Foundation Skills” to the students in which about 150 students benefited.

Co Curricular Activity

Participation of the students in any one of the activities (Viz) Seminars, Conferences, Workshops and Symposia etc. conducted by other colleges during their courses of study is compulsory for the award of degree and it should be duly certified by the Head of the Department and submitted to the Controller of Examinations with a copy of the certificate of participation.
