

IQAC SUMMARY REPORT – 2021 -2022

Significant Activities and contributions made by IQAC

- 1. IQAC suggested that while preparing the list of programmes to be organised by various departments for the academic year 2021 2022, the vision, the mission of the college, the industries expectation of the skills to be possessed by the students are to be kept in mind. Accordingly the departments have prepared the list of programmes in such a way that they would develop their soft skills, enhance their knowledge in the concerned area of study and develop positive attitude.
- 2. Since the format for the preparation of Self Study Report and the procedure for the assessment and accreditation have been changed by the NAAC, it was suggested that the FDP may be organised to make the teachers aware of the changed procedure and filling up of the format from the preparation of Self Study Report.
- 3. Instead of giving training to the students for developing their communication skills and their mathematical aptitude outside the class hours IQAC suggested that it could be preferable if the above 2 topics are included in the regular working hours, in order to get better results.

MoU's Signed

The college have signed MoU with the companies/Institutions like Aakam Industrial Training and Research Institute, Kovai Consultancy services, Sprout Knowledge Solutions, Kovai Vasantha Vasal Kavi Mandram, Karam's Itech Solutions, Canny Consortium of Colleges, Edunet, CIET TBI, Innovation Online Training Academy, Pupil Rhythm Counselling Centre and 173 students were benefited through 15 collaborative activities through this MoU.

Seminars and Conferences Organized

The departments of Computer Science, Commerce, and Business Administration together organised 45 workshops, guest lectures, seminars, extension activities, and FDPs. Four Faculty served as resource persons in seminars conducted by the other institutions. Faculty members and students have participated in 288 Seminars/Webinars, and 175 Faculty Development Programmes.

Research Details

The Department of Commerce and Computer Science were recognized as research departments by the Bharathiar University. 6 Ph.D Scholars in the Department of Computer Science and 6 PhD scholars in the Department of Commerce are pursuing their research. 5 faculty in the Department of Computer Science and 1 faculty in the Department of Commerce are recognized as Research Guides. 30 papers were presented, 10 research papers were published in reputed International Journals. 4 Scholars were awarded with M.Phil degree in commerce/ Computer science and 1 with Ph.D degree in Commerce.

Administrative Training Programme

Computer training is provided to all the support staff. They are encouraged to enhance their qualification joining distance education program. In case they become eligible for appointment to a higher cadre or to a teaching position they are either promoted or absorbed as a lecturer.

Result

As far as the results of the University examinations are concerned we are proud to announce that the students are able to get 100% results in 187 subjects of UG and PG courses. We also congratulate the faculty members who have put in strenuous efforts to produce cent percent results in various subjects.221 UG students and 12 PG students were graduated this year.

Bridge Course

Bridge course is conducted for newly admitted students by the department of English, mathematics, commerce, and computer science for 30 hours to bridge the gap between school and college education. It helps the students to have a smooth transition from school to college.

Placement and Training

The Finishing School Programme, Skill development Programme by Infosys,TCS affirmative Action programme by TCS and Skill development programme by Financial Literacy by ICT Academy were conducted successfully train the students in soft skills, aptitude and technical skills.

This year, Vibe Integrated Private Ltd, Suriti, IMF Private Ltd, KGISL Private Ltd, HRH NEXT CONTACT SERVICES, Sri Kumaran Thangamaligai Group of Companies have visited our campus during this academic year and have issued 213 offers of appointment. The maximum annual income for those who have placed is Rs 3 lakhs..

Similarly the TCS one of the top IT Companies, as a part of their CSR choose our college every year invariably for giving training in the name of "Affirmative action Training program", totally free of cost for 100 hours to the economically backward and socially downtrodden students

of our college. 90 students were benefited by the training. Similarly Infosys also conducts a free training program for 100 hours in the name of "Global Business Foundation Skills" to the students in which about 150 students benefited.

Laurels achieved by students

2 of our students brought laurels by winning prizes in various competitions such as poster design, photography contest, product marketing, quiz, logo identification, personality identification, handloom fashion shows, facial paintings, Best Manager, Best Programmer, Maths quiz, wealth from waste and essay writing conducted by various other institutions.

College Social Responsibility activity through Clubs and Cells

As a part of College Social Responsibility, various activities are organized by Women Empowerment Cell, ECO-Club, Fine arts club, Auditor's club, Pi Club, Photography Club, Programmers Club, Science Club, Talker's club Citizens Consumer Club, Youth Red Cross, Red Ribbon Club and National Service Scheme.

The Students actively participated in campus, Blood donation, Awareness programmes, Rallies to create awareness on prevention of certain diseases, environmental degradation, tree planting, conducting Medical Camps, Creating Awareness on Women Health, Consumer Rights and Right to Information Act.

The NSS, RRC & YRC along with the various departments actively participate in social activities that benefit the local neighborhood.2 medical Camps and 3 awareness programme were conducted by our NSS team of Members.
